Paul, a minister not by his own choice,

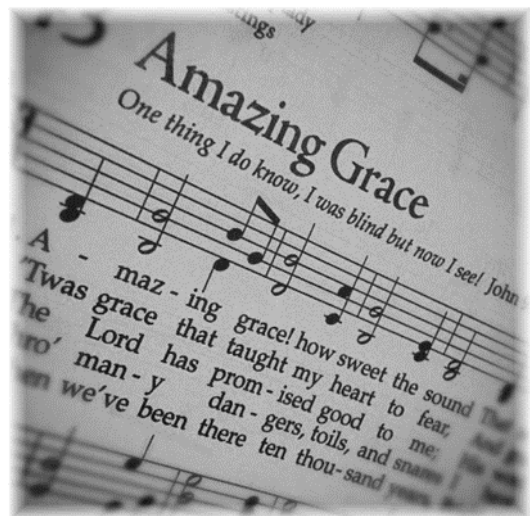
Paul, a minister by plan,

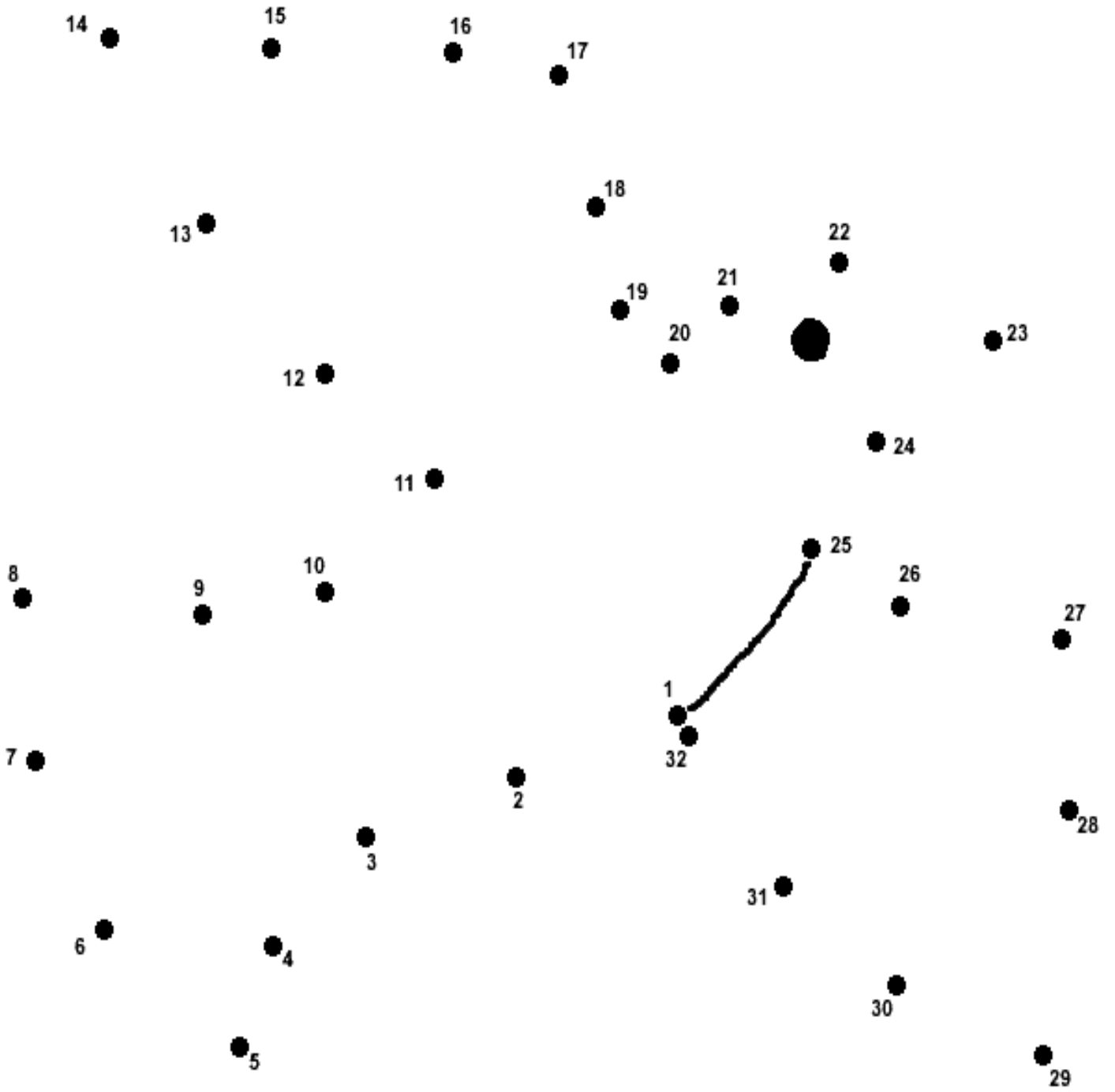
