As I write this month's article, I noted that we are in the midst of what has often been referred to as "the Dog Days of summer". If you are familiar with this expression then you might also relate it to the hot, steamy summer days that the Farmer's Almanac refers to as the peak period of hot and humid weather occurring during late July and August. For the



Greeks and Romans of ancient times, the "Dog Days" were believed to be a time of drought, bad luck, and unrest, when dogs and people alike would be driven mad by the extreme heat. Growing up, my heart would sink a bit because it meant we would soon be back at school, the street lights would come on sooner requiring us to put our bikes away and head inside, and late night television would be no more. In essence, it signaled a time of transition when everything "summer" would soon start moving in the other direction – cooler nights, marching band practice, county fairs and scanning the newspaper for homeroom assignments. As a gardener, it meant the season's harvest was about to peak too with plants giving their last hoorah before fall planting took its place.

The longest season of the church year—Ordinary Time— when the paraments that dress our sanctuary are in a "state of green" for what seems to be forever, coincides with the summer months. Without a major feast day for the season until Reformation in October, Ordinary Time can *feel* like "the dog days of summer". Ordinary Time and the dog days of summer, however, do not mean we have to be at a standstill as the calendar year invites us to move into action in other ways – the school year, for instance – and in faithful ways. Writer, Jack King, notes, "As with the landscape of the home, so also with the landscape of the heart, there is always work to be done in one's life to conform our lives into the likeness of Christ, adjusting to place our hope, not in the things of the world, but trusting in the guidance of God."

Here at Faith, the calendar invites you, as do I, to adjust your schedule a bit and take a small step forward into the life of the church: attend the upcoming Family Banquet, get involved in the worship liturgy (altar guild, assisting minister, lector, acolyte, usher, choir), the Heartstrings ministry or Youth in Action, attend a movie matinee or participate in the upcoming text studies "HeBrews". This time of year <u>can</u> be a season for spiritual renewal, "even with the limitations we sense in the weather of the heart' - and of the world".


