PSALM 139

You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. ² You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. ³ You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. ⁴Before a word is on my tongue, you, Lord, know it completely. ⁵ You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. ⁶ Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain. ⁷Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? ⁸ If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. ⁹ If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, ¹⁰ even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast. ¹¹ If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," ¹² even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you. ¹³ For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. ¹⁴ I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. ¹⁵ My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place, when I was woven together in the depths of the earth. ¹⁶ Your eyes saw my unformed body; all the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be. ¹⁷ How precious to me are your thoughts, God! How vast is the sum of them! ¹⁸ Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand when I awake, I am still with you.

What do we expect from God on a daily basis?

Psalm 139 is one of my personal favorites as it speaks to the presence of God in our lives even before we are born. No matter the season of our lives – or the season of the church calendar - God is there. In the midst of our days, our work and our play; however, we sometimes forget to "see" Him there. How many times have we looked at the sunset, admired the landscape of the rolling hills, smiled at the simple joys found in the laughter and play of our children and grandchildren, or the wagging of a furry companion's greeting, and realized God's gift to us in each of these moments? How many times have we walked by someone with barely a hello or a nod or a wave, not seeing them as God sees them — a beloved child of God?

How many times have we gathered around the table to enjoy a meal, conversation, fellowship, and not thanked God for family, for friends, for community? How many times have we walked through the halls of the church as just a means for getting here and there, to and for, without recognizing, acknowledging, and remembering the work of our hands from years past, in days present, and in our hopes for the future? Do we see, recognize, acknowledge, and remember God's blessings found in each of these on a daily basis; do we see the wonder of it all? Do we live, work and play —in holy anticipation—looking forward to how God might reveal himself this day.....



From the halls of Faith - The Church Calendar - Grades 3 &4, 1983

Author and blogger John Van de Laar notes that "Pentecost Sunday is a pivot point in the Church Calendar. It's mostly celebrated as a stand-alone event in the year, but it marks a significant shift.

This is the day we move from the first half of the year, where the focus is on Jesus' birth, life, death and resurrection, to the second half of the year, where we focus on how to live as Jesus did.

The gift of Spirit at Pentecost is the gift of sight to see the wonderland of God's reign.

It's the gift of longing to see that world become a reality among us.

And it's the gift of courage and strength to begin to live the way of Christ here and now.

And for me there is great value in celebrating Pentecost as a season rather than just an event."

This is an important event/season to look forward to. Maybe we, too, can find new ways to celebrate the gift of sight to see the "wonderland of God's reign" and "see" Him here...there...and everywhere....in the midst of our days, at work and at play, living in holy anticipation with a desire to know God even more.


