The more we study and read and listen to our texts from the Bible, be it during worship, Adult Sunday School, Bible Study, WELCA's group study, personal reading and reflection and even our children's sermons, the more we come to realize that God's ways are not our ways. What I mean to say is that all the things that God has done isn't what we would have expected. For example, in our weekly Bible study of Genesis, we have read and talked about God's promises to Noah, to Abraham and to humanity. When Adam and Eve listen to the "truth" of a snake rather than God we expect God to wonder why in the world God would continue to want to be in relationship with humans. We expect God to throw in the towel when Abraham tells half-truths about his wife Sarah in order to save his life not once but three times.

Who would have expected a barren woman to become pregnant and have a child at age 90? Yet, Sarah did. Who would have expected a sea to part, water to come from a stone, blind and deaf to see and hear again...people to be healed of lifetime illnesses? Yet the Bible gives us eye witness accounts throughout. Who would have expected an "ordinary" son of a carpenter, a teacher and a preacher to give up his life on a cross for us? Yet, Jesus did. Who would have expected a man who died and was buried to walk and talk and eat with friends again just three days later? Yet Jesus did just that. The Bible contains story after story after story of God working his unexpected grace, mercy, and love for us. He does so even when we do not deserve it...that's how God works! We find this not only through His word, but in the forgiveness bestowed with our confessions and in the gifts we receive in the bread and wine (and grape juice) offered at His table.

As we move through this season and beyond, gazing at the beauty found in creation as the sun rises and sets, trees blossom, birds sing and bees start to buzz; as we watch children at play, cast our lines into nearby streams, dig into the dirt, ride through the mountains, or sit on the porch sipping some-

thing refreshing – may we continue to celebrate the unexpected from God in the "ordinary" moments of our daily lives...all borne from the love of God. Easter is not just one day...but every day.
