It's that time of year when the abundance of our gardens begins to emerge and we share in that abundance, be it cucumbers, summer squash, zucchini, or tomatoes, together with the stories and humorous puns, as well as the plethora of recipes, that come along with them, especially when it comes to zucchini and squash!

Growing up, my dad's garden also reaped a plentiful harvest of squash. This meant squash for supper at least twice a week. He relished those suppers as my mother would place plate after plate of the egg-and-flour-dipped coins of gold on the table for the six of us...it seemed never ending and we were filled. I will always treasure those memories sitting around the table with fork in hand as we ate together.

This year I am trying some new seeds out – an upright summer squash from Burpee called "Rise & Shine" and a round zucchini that looks like something you would find on a billiard table – "one green zucchini to the left pocket!" One of each are gracing my plants so far, primed for picking. Not prolific as my dad's harvest but a start. As I was thinking of the abundance we share from our gardens, I cannot help but think of the abundance we receive daily: family, neighbors, community, the glorious sunrises and sunsets, the beauty of the Laurel Highlands' rolling farmlands and mountain vistas – we <u>are</u> truly blessed. Our abundant blessings, however, extend beyond all of this...to the unexpected abundance of mercy and forgiveness – all of which lead us back to God.

"In one of Paul's disputed letters (that's another story for another day), this same experience of reflecting on God's abundance is shared, as his life is described before Jesus, when he was a "persecutor and a violent man" (1 Timothy 1:13); "the worst of sinners" (v. 16). Into Paul's brokenness, God lavishly poured out grace, faith, and love (v. 14). After reflecting on all the abundance in his life, the apostle couldn't help but express praise to God, declaring Him worthy of all "honor and glory for ever and ever" (v. 17). Like Paul, we all received an overwhelming abundance of grace when Jesus' rescued us from sin (v. 15)."



As we pause to reflect on all the blessings, we join Paul in grateful praise to our generous God. A generosity of which we are called to share with everyone out of the abundance we have received from Him.

May the remaining days of summer find you enjoying, treasuring in, and sharing in His abounding, and abundant love with the whole neighborhood!
