In other words, they're doing what many of us have been doing for decades. Turns out our church community has been "trendy" long before TikTok caught on!

A generation raised on screens is discovering that their souls are hungry for something they can touch. Something slow. Something quiet. Something that doesn't demand their attention every five seconds. Researchers say these hobbies help people feel grounded, connected, and human again. They give folks a chance to forget themselves for a little while in a world that keeps shoving their own reflection back at them. Honestly, when I look around our congregation, I see that happening already. Our Creative Crafters meet once a month, making things for our homebound members, decorations for the fellowship hall, gifts for our youngsters, and yes—sometimes just for the joy of creating something beautiful. There's laughter, stories, shared scissors and glue bottles, and that gentle hum of people who feel at home with one another. If you've been thinking about joining, this is your nudge. There's always room at the table.

Our Feeding the Flock ministry does the same thing in a different way—hands chopping vegetables, stirring soups, baking quick breads, providing meals to folks facing medical emergencies, long-term illness, new babies, or financial strain. It's love you can taste. It's care you can carry in a dish. It's the gospel with a side of stuffing balls! Our choir welcomes every voice, and we're starting a choir for younger voices too. Singing isn't just beautiful—it expands our lungs, strengthens our core, lifts our spirits, and gives glory and praise to God. Kids Kingdom, Youth in Action, He-Brews Bible Study, and Adult Sunday School all offer places where people gather around Scripture, conversation, and community. Then there are the quiet saints who fix things around the church, keeping us safe, warm, and able to gather. Their hands preach a sermon every time they tighten a bolt.

All of these ministries have something in common: they're embodied. They're hands-on. They're real. They offer the kind of grounded, human connection that so many young people are craving right now. As Paul reminds us, "Now you are the body of Christ, and individually members of it." We are meant to be connected, meant to move, meant to serve, meant to create, meant to be together.

Maybe this whole "Grandma Hobby" trend is simply reminding us of what the church has known all along: people need places where they can be human together. Places where hands are busy, hearts are open, and the noise of the world fades into the background.

It is good for us to do so—to be a community in Christ, together. It makes the days easier. It gets us moving, talking, laughing. It's a way for us to take care of our bodies, minds, and spirits...the very temples God created.

So if you're looking for that kind of place, we have plenty. Creative Crafters, Feeding the Flock, choirs, Kids Kingdom, Youth in Action, He-Brews, Adult Sunday School, and the fix-it crew. Mark your calendars and pull up a chair; there's a seat waiting for you and we'd love to have you join in.

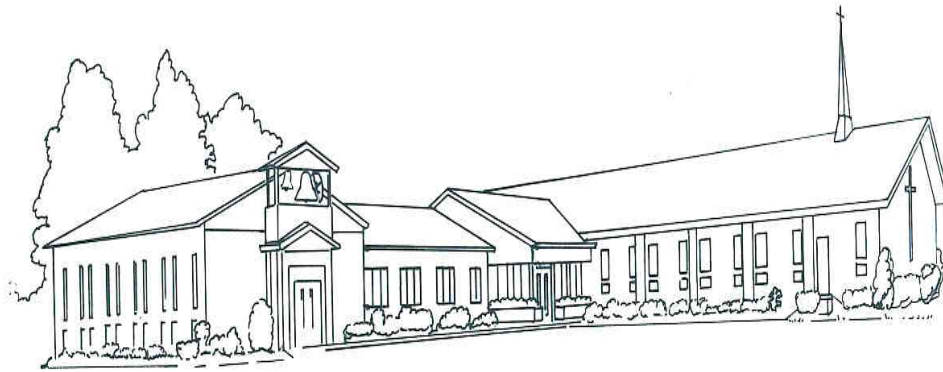
